This WILL impact our school every month, as the boy's bathroom in our middle school wing was vandalized prior to our school closure. Please read the list below:

- September: Vandalize school bathrooms
- October: Smack a staff member
- November: Kiss your friend's girlfriend at school
- December: Deck the halls and show your balls
- January: Jab a breast
- February: Mess up school signs
- March: Make a mess in the courtyard or cafeteria
- April: "Grab some eggz" (another stealing challenge)
- May: Ditch day
- June: Flip off in the front office
- July: Spray a neighbor's fence

The social media challenge for the month of October encourages students to slap teachers. Behavior associated with these challenges, often called "Devious Licks," will not be tolerated and will involve school suspension or expulsion, and NJ State Police intervention.
