MLP HAWKS Athletics Traveling Team Rules

1. Attendance: 3 unexcused absences from practices or games will result in removal from team. If you are not in school the day of practice or game it will be an excused absence. If you have a doctor's appointment after school during a scheduled event (practice or game), a doctor's note **must be provided** for it to count as an excused absence. Any player having more than 8 absences, excused or unexcused will be removed from the team. Please note, if you are absent from school the day of a game you cannot play in that game. All players must participate in at least 4 practices before being eligible to play in a game or scrimmage.
2. Discipline: Detention: Any player receiving a teacher detention, lunch detention, or after school detention the day of a practice or game will not be permitted to take part in that day's event. Any player receiving a teacher detention, lunch detention, or after school detention on a day that we do not have practice or a game will have to sit out the first portion of the next scheduled game.
Suspension: Any student receiving a day of in school suspension will not be permitted to play or practice that day and will also miss the next scheduled game. Any student receiving out of school suspension will be removed from the team for the remainder of the season.
3. Any equipment issued for practice to any player should be brought to every practice. Game time can be limited for any player that does not bring practice equipment to practice. (i.e. Practice Jersey)
4. Players are responsible for his/her game uniform. If a player does not bring it to a game, the player will not play. If it is an away game you will not travel with the team.
5. A fine card will be issued to any player that does not turn in all equipment that was issued to them during the season. A copy of the fine card will go to the Main Office.
6. All players are expected to be courteous to our teaching staff, coaching staff, opposing coaches, opposing players, fans, teammates and to all officials. Game time can be limited if this rule is broken and it could lead to suspension or expulsion from the team.
7. All players are responsible to have transportation home for all practices, and games. Students are expected to follow all school rules when on the bus or attending athletic events.

These rules have been implemented by the coaching staff and the Athletic Department. These rules, in addition to our school rules, are in place to make the season enjoyable for all that are involved.

By signing the permission slip, the player and parent/guardian agree to adhere to these team rules.
