MLP Families:

The circumstances resulting from COVID-19 continue to quickly evolve throughout our nation. While there are still no confirmed cases in Cumberland County, our district has elected to join the effort in limiting potential exposure. In consultation with the Cumberland County Department of Health and the Superintendents in the county, we have made the decision to close our schools beginning on Tuesday, March 17, 2020.

The Lawrence Township School District will remain closed until Monday, April 20th. We will continue to monitor this changing situation and consult with the Cumberland County Department of Health and the local/state Education Departments to determine any other changes to our plan.

Our school will be open for a full-day of school tomorrow Monday, March 16th. The HAWKS NEST program will be open until 6:00pm. All other after-school games and practices will be cancelled.

Please send your child to school tomorrow so that they can be prepared both mentally and physically for the school closure. However, as always, if they are sick, please keep your child home and there will be ways to retrieve their work.

Home Learning Packet Information

1- Please empty your child's Home Learning Packet. Take the papers out of the clear folder and put them in a safe place. Those are the papers that should be completed first. The first packet of papers will be referred to as Cycle 1.

2- Put the clear folder in your child's bookbag and have them bring it to school tomorrow. Your child's teachers will fill those clear folders with the Home Learning Packet for Cycle 2, or the next 5-days of instruction.

3- If your child was absent Friday and is coming to school tomorrow, he/she will receive their Home Learning Packets for the 1st and 2nd 5-Day Cycles.

4- If your child will be absent tomorrow, you can pick-up your child's Home Learning Packets tomorrow, following the guidelines below:

Home Learning Packet pick-up will be available from 4:00-7:00pm.

Packets can be received along the side of the building, where the cafeteria doors are located. **DO NOT** come to the front of the school.

A survey will be coming later tonight for ALL FAMILIES to complete regarding your need for food.

School will be open tomorrow, Monday, March 16th for a full-day.

School will be closed Tuesday, March 17th-Sunday, April 19th.
