

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitor Reporting Requirements Not Met

For Myron Powell Elementary School

The drinking water system at Myron Powell Elementary School violated drinking water standards during the second quarter of 2021 (April through June of 2021). Even though this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct the situation.

We routinely monitoring for the presence of drinking water containments. The drinking water samples Radiological were required to be analyzed during the period April through June of 2021, the laboratory never collected the Radiological sample, due to laboratory error.

What does this mean?

This is not an immediate risk. There is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.

What is being done?

We are working with the Laboratory and taking corrective action to make sure this does not happen in the future. Eurofins QC Inc laboratories will continue to follow NJDEP required monitoring schedule off the NJDEP Waterwatch and continue to review our monthly reminders.
